The Cleveland Orchestra Youth Orchestra, Brett Mitchell, music director, will hear auditions in May for middle school and high school musicians who study privately and play violin, viola, cello, double bass, harp, flute, piccolo, oboe, English horn, clarinet, bassoon, contrabassoon, French horn, trumpet, trombone, bass trombone, tuba, percussion, and keyboard instruments. Founded in 1985 by David and Linda Cerone as a summer session of the Cleveland Institute of Music, the Encore School of Strings Festival produced such distinguished alumni as Hilary Hahn, Leila Josefowicz, Ray Chen, Zuill Bailey, and Amir Eldan. Discontinued in 2008, Encore will be reborn as the Encore Chamber Music Summer Program, and relocated to the Gilmour Academy in Gates Mills. The program, which will run from June 12 to July 10, will be directed by Jinjoo Cho and staffed by a faculty that includes the Miró Quartet, the Calidore String Quartet, Paul Katz, Hyun Soo Kim, Jaime Laredo, Paul Kantor, and Benjamin Hochman.
