Responsibilities

- Select repertoire and develop programs for three concerts per year: fall, winter and spring; other performances possible
- Rehearse the chorus Sunday evenings 7PM to 9:15PM from early September through the spring concert; secure competent coverage for any rehearsals that need to be missed; conduct dress rehearsals before each concert, as needed. Rehearsals should work toward mastery of the selected works and continuous improvement of the members musical skills.
- Responsible for engaging and supervising a rehearsal accompanist
- Responsible for the recruitment and hiring of guest musicians and soloists for concerts
- Responsible for preparing the accompanying orchestra/ensemble for concerts
- Serve as primary artistic spokesperson for the organization, represent Choral Arts Cleveland in media appearances
- Accountable to a Board of Trustees, serving as Ex-Officio (non voting) member of the board.; attendance at meetings (4 to 5 per year) is expected

Desired Qualifications

- B.A. in music with minimum of five years experience as a choral conductor with documented success
- Strong teaching ability and artistic creativity
- Strong, positive interpersonal communication skills
- Good collaboration skills with both singers and instrumentalists
- A sense of “community”
- Commitment to the local area; a minimum two year commitment to the directorship of Choral Arts Cleveland
