

## Cleveland International Piano Competition, Steinway announce new concert series at Gilmour Academy

The Academy is the first private school in the Midwest to earn this distinction. Held the third Tuesday of each month, every concert in the series will be played on the school's newest Steinway. The monthly one-hour performances will be preceded by light refreshments in the Tudor Gardens at 5:30 pm, with music starting at 6:00 pm.
